Homeowner proposal for change to the exterior of your home

This form is the first step for permission to make a permanent change to the exterior of your home (or changes to the interior of your home that are visible from the exterior). Per your land lease rider, homeowners who want to make such a change shall give written notice to the other Svaboda Court homeowners and to Proud Ground, informing them of the planned change no less than 30 days prior to making permanent changes to the exterior of your home (or changes to the interior of your home that are visible from the exterior) including but not limited to home colors, window treatments, ornaments, shading devices, lattices or other permanent supports for landscaping, flags and banners, and communications devices. If no homeowner or Proud Ground objects to the change within 30 days, you may make the change.

Process

- This form is the required first step for all proposals.
- Only one proposal per form.
- Submit completed forms to *request@proudground.org*. Please put "Homeowner Request" in the subject line. You may also mail this to the Proud Ground office, attn: Homeowner Requests.
- Your proposal will be reviewed in the order received; please allow at least three weeks for a response. The response time may take longer if there are many proposals, if this proposal requires research of costs or zoning issues, etc.
- You may be asked to provide more information.
